Dear Parent or Carers,

Our school has purchased Reading Plus, an online reading program, after the excellent results received from last year's pilot. The purpose of the Reading Plus program is to help your child become a more reflective reader. Reading Plus will help children develop the skills they need to be proficient readers and lifelong learners. Through regular Reading Plus practice, reading will become easier, comprehension will increase, and your child will make meaningful connections between what they are reading and what they are learning.

Your child will be able to complete Reading Plus assignments outside of school on a computer or tablet that has Internet access. When you have access, you will see that assignments in each program can be completed in any order, but please remind your child that reading assignments are the most important. The program will keep track of assignments completed each week as well as your child's progress toward the overall lesson goals. Weekly assignments reset every Sunday night at 11:59 p.m., so children can work on completing weekly assignments over the weekend. Please encourage your child to do additional work in Reading Plus if they complete the weekly assignment.

We will have log-in details for your child over the next week and once these have been set up, they will be sent out so you can have access at home. We will also provide more information to how you can track your child's progress once the program is up and running.
