Dear parent and/or carer

Expectations

Thank you so much for all your support this term, especially with stationery and uniform. Could I please remind you that students are required to be equipped for lessons with the following items:

a reading book, a planner and a pencil case containing (as a minimum):

- a couple of blue/black pens (in case one runs out or breaks);
- a green pen (for their corrections and improvement tasks);
- a couple of pencils (with a pencil sharpener and rubber);
- at least a 15cm ruler;
- a protractor;
- **[UPPER SCHOOL ONLY]** a compass
- **[UPPER SCHOOL ONLY]** a scientific calculator – we recommend students have a Casio fx-83GT PLUS.

From January, we will be opening a small stationery shop within school at both our lower and upper school sites, should your child require a replacement to any stationery during the school day.

May I also remind you that it is expected that all pupils wear the following items of uniform:

- Black school shoes (not trainers)
- A school blazer
- A shirt & tie (clip-on ties only from January except for Year 11 as they have only short time of uniform left!)
- A school jumper [optional]
- School trousers

Pupils are welcome to arrive to school in a coat, but this should be removed as soon as they enter the school building. If you have any issues with buying any items for school, please do not hesitate to contact me in the New Year.
