Dear Parent and/or Carer,

Your child is currently completing a unit in the A level geography course which relates to how cities change over time and how issues such as retail development and the use of derelict land are managed.

In order to support this work, I am proposing that all Yr 12 geography students take part in a visit to Newcastle to look at a number of examples of urban regeneration and retail redevelopment.
