You said....

“It is often difficult to get your child to complete homework at home”

We did....

South Avenue and Acklington Road pupils can access the Quay, at each site, to complete homework at either break or lunchtime. Some pupils require additional support; therefore, homework is emailed to staff in the Quay to complete with pupils.

You said...

“Transition is important and a time your child often struggles. You are worried about transition from year 4-5 and 7-8”

We did....

Enhanced transition programmes for years 4-5 and 7-8 pupils have been planned. Parents will receive details soon after the Easter holidays.

You said....

“Your child would benefit from social skills intervention”

We did....

Support staff have been trained to deliver Lego intervention and inference training. Sessions are being delivered on a weekly basis.

“You would benefit from additional support and advice regarding your child’s condition/difficulties”

Parental training sessions, delivered by the Northumberland SEND services, will be offered to all parents in the summer term.
