Gigantic June: prizes for great behaviour and attendance

Great behaviour

We are piloting a new scheme to reward great behaviour in school. Every time any member of staff wishes to reward behaviour in school, they will issue a raffle ticket. The student must jot down their name, form class and the name of the person issuing the ticket on the back. They can ask for help to do this.

The student should then post their ticket in the "Gigantic June" box at South Avenue reception or at the pastoral office at Acklington Road. This can only be done at breaks or lunchtimes. There is a draw at the end of each day on both sites for a small prize. All the tickets on both sites are then kept until the end of the month when there is a final draw for a £50 gift card.

Great attendance

Students with 100% attendance for the whole of June will be entered for a separate draw at the end of the month. The winning student will receive a £50 gift card as will a parent/carer in their household - after all, it is you to ensure your child gets to school each day. Students with poor punctuality will not be entered for the draw.

We will monitor the impact of the scheme and if successful we will run it again later in the year.
