Visit to Scotland Street School, Glasgow on Friday 17 May 2019

Your child has opted to look at the work of Charles Rennie Mackintosh as their Passion Day activity this term.

Everyone in the group is invited to join me to go to Scotland Street School museum in Glasgow to look at the building he created and his art work inside. You need to give permission using www.schoolgateway.com or the School Gateway app.

We will leave from the Acklington Road site about 0830 (or as soon as the last bus arrives) and the students need to meet in reception there. School uniform is required. I would encourage your child to bring a phone so they can take photos of the art work but also to call you half an hour before we are due to arrive back at the Acklington Road site. I expect this to be at 1630. If you are unable to collect your child, please let me know using the website or app.

The visit is free though the museum has a small shop selling basic things like pencils and keyrings. Your child can opt for a packed lunch or I can get a few picnic items in for them. Just let me know if they are not bringing a packed lunch and I will contact you to find out what sort of things they like to eat.

If your child is in Year 6, you will receive some information about an alternative event happening next Friday (the students don't know about this yet – it's our secret for the moment) and if they want to go on that instead, just let me know. I won't be offended.
