Dear parent or carer

Year 7 Reward Day - 12 June 2019

As a result of their hard work and great attitude to learning this academic year, we would like to reward your child with a day of fun and unusual activities on Wednesday 12 June 2019. We have worked with the pupils so that they have had some influence on the choice of activities. Our combined decision has resulted in the following schedule:

- Morning – Visit from the ice-cream van with a free ice cream
- Afternoon – Picnic on the field followed by super bazooka water-based combat (a supervised water fight)

It would be lovely if your child could bring an item of food in to school to share it with their friends as part of the picnic. We will, of course, supplement the picnic for all children with goodies of our own.

Only those children who would like to take part in the water fight will do so. If your child would rather take part in a more gentle activity, we will arrange for them to be supervised. The water fight will have an authorised risk assessment and strict rules of engagement – only water pistols and water balloons allowed, no running indoors to get buckets or hose pipes! Staff at school will prepare water balloons. Children should not bring their own. All of the rules will be explained to the children beforehand. They will be issued with a list of suggested clothes to change into in the afternoon, ie appropriate footwear and a swimming costume underneath shorts and t-shirt. The fight will be stopped in the event of any foul play. Children will be expected to bring a towel to dry themselves before changing back into their school uniform and travelling home at the end of the day.

In the case of inclement weather, we will postpone the afternoon activities to Thursday 13 June 2019 and inform you of the decision by the lunchtime of 12 June.
