Dear parent/carer,

Due to the sports hall being used for mock examinations over the next two weeks from Monday 22nd November - Friday 4th December, we will not have access to indoor facilities, including changing rooms for students PE lessons. At JCSC we understand the importance of physical activity for our students in terms of the physical, social and emotional benefits. Therefore, we still intend for students to take part in their allocated lessons during those two weeks. To make sure this is achievable students are to attend school in their PE kit on their PE days only for the dates stated. The PE uniform guidance is available on our website as well as in the student planner.

As a reminder-

All jewellery must be removed, and hair tied back before PE lessons for health and safety reasons.

**COMPULSORY**

JCSC sports blue T-shirt.

JCSC sports shorts, or leggings, or tracksuit bottoms.

Trainers.

**OPTIONAL**

¼ zip JCSC top.

A school hoodie may be worn over the blue JCSC sports top in colder weather with teacher's permission.

Football boots can be worn during activities such as cross country, football and rugby with teacher's permission.

No other items of sportswear are allowed. If students do not have a JCSC hoodie or ¼ zip top they may wear their school jumper or blazer whilst around school but will be asked to remove them for their PE lesson. As we will be outside on the grass, a spare pair of trainers and socks is recommended, along with a plastic bag so that students don't have wet feet all day and so their schoolwork and bag does not get marked.

I am aware of a handful of students who are still waiting delivery of their kit by Emblematic. If this is the case, please could a note be written in the student's planner, along with the order number and I will chase this for you.
