Jarrow Hall visit – May 2022

As part of our English and Humanities curriculum, we are excited to announce that we will be taking Year 5 to visit the Anglo-Saxon Farm and Village at Jarrow Hall on Thursday 12th or Friday 13th May to experience what Anglo-Saxon life was like. They will experience Anglo-Saxon Food and Farming which will include exploring a working Anglo-Saxon style farm, investigating the Anglo-Saxon Kingdoms and Battles where they will have the opportunity to re-enact an Anglo-Saxon battle as well as exploring runes, magic and medicine.
