Theatre Visit

We are extremely excited to inform you that we have booked a trip to the Theatre Royal, Newcastle, on Wednesday 9 November 2022 to see *An Inspector Calls*. The performance will start at 2pm so students will be leaving during the school day and will return at approximately 5pm. Students are studying the play as part of their GCSE English Literature exam and this is worth 20% of their final grade. It is an amazing opportunity to see the play performed on stage, as intended by J.B.Priestley.

The tickets will be available to students who will be in Y10 and Y11 in November 2022 (current Y9 and Y10) as well as A' Level English Literature students. We have secured 50 places for the visit therefore the tickets will be available on a **first come, first served basis**.

The full cost of the trip, per child, for the bus and the theatre ticket is £30.33. However, we have successfully managed to secure funding to reduce the cost so students will be required to pay £22.50. In order to give parents/carers time to organise the funds, the places will be available from 1st June (not before). We request that **payments are made online via MCAS** (My Child at School). If students are unable to pay online, they can bring cash in but online is preferred. The trip will be closed when all of the spaces are filled.

Additional information will be sent out to the parent of students who successfully secure a place on the trip.
