Next week year 5 attend their trip to Jarrow Hall. This letter provides you details about which day your child will be attending the school trip, suitable clothing and what they need to bring with them.

Mrs Allman and Miss Davies classes will be attending Jarrow Hall on Thursday 12th May. Miss Armstrong and Mrs Courtnage classes will be attending Jarrow Hall on Friday 13th May. We will be leaving school at approximately 9.30am and will be returning to school for 3.10pm.

As we are at Jarrow Hall all day, a packed lunch is required, and we suggest that your child brings a water bottle for throughout the day. If your child is entitled to a free school meal a packed lunch will be provided. If you are entitled to a free school meal but would rather prepare your child's own packed lunch, please inform reception on 01665 710636 so we can avoid wastage.

We want your child to enjoy their visit. As the session will likely include outdoor work, please ensure your child is dressed appropriately with sturdy outdoor shoes or wellies, if appropriate, long sleeves and trousers to protect from nettles and insects and appropriate clothing for the weather. This includes a raincoat and/or application of sun cream before the visit as appropriate. We advise old clothes and footwear as they might get dirty.

We may be able to visit the gift shop whilst we are there, so your child can bring with them a small amount of money to spend if you wish.
