Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been lovely to see your children back in school after the Easter break. The summer term is always a busy one! As we start the new term, I would like to update you on some events that will be taking place over the next few weeks.

Next weekend is the King's coronation. To mark the occasion, we will have a coronation themed lunch and a "bake off". On the morning of the 5th May pupils are invited to bake a cake, pie or scones and bring them into school to be judged. The baking will then be cut up and sold to pupils in school at break and lunchtime. The money raised from the bake off will be used to buy a coronation tree from the woodland trust which will be dedicated to JCSC pupils; this will be a fitting tribute to the new King I am sure you will agree. Any left-over money raised will be to contribute towards end of year activities.
