Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you're enjoying the summer break – I thought this would be a good time to give you a short update on plans for the start of term, some important adjustments to our uniform policy and changes in our staffing.

Dates for next term

This September, the first two days of the new academic year are training days and closed to all students. The first day of term for students in years 5, 6, 7 and 8 is **Wednesday September 6**th.

Please remember that, from September, all staff and students will be on one site – the former upper school site on Acklington Road.

Students in all other year groups return on Thursday September 7th.

Uniform

Thank you for ensuring that our uniform policy is adhered to. I know that you'll be stocking up on at least some new items over summer, so please refer to <u>the uniform page on our website</u> to ensure you buy the appropriate things. One major change is that we accept that, in the current financial climate, buying school-specific shoes can be a challenge for some families. We have, therefore, decided to amend our policy on shoes to include any <u>all black, leather, polishable</u> trainers such as Nike Air Force 1, Converse All Star Low and Vans.
