I would like to take this opportunity to thank the year 11 students for their fantastic attitude towards the mock examination period. This has provided an excellent foundation to build upon for their forthcoming examination in May.

As always, we are planning to host a prom for year 11 to celebrate their hard work and commitment to their GCSE examinations. We know a lot of the students are looking forward to this event and plan to make it as memorable as possible. For this to happen we need your help.

The year 11 prom will be held at The Alnwick Garden on **Thursday 27th June 2024**. Tickets for the event are priced at £40, this includes venue costs only. A £20 deposit is required by Sunday 4th February the remaining £20 will be required by the end of April, this can be paid via the My Child at School app which is live now.

Students will arrive at JCSC from 6pm for a welcome drink in the main hall, with coaches leaving school for the event at 6.45pm.

The coaches will leave the Alnwick Garden at 11pm and drop off at Widdrington, Hadston and Amble.

Last year costs for transport, disco, food, photo booth and a photographer, a magician, caricature artist, video booth and a few other treats were sponsored by local businesses. Without this funding, last year a ticket to this event would have cost each child in excess of £75 per head.
