A Level trip to Amble Beach

As part of the A level Biology course, I have organised a trip on the 7th May to Amble Beach, East Cemetery. This trip will give the students an excellent opportunity to study the local ecology and complete a required practical assessment: investigation of the effect of environmental factors on the distribution of plant species.

In order to keep travel costs as low as possible, students will be making their own way to and from the Beach. The visit will take place during the afternoon of 7th May during their normal Biology lesson time, so no other subjects will be affected.

Students need to be at the Beach for 12.40pm and will be finished at approximately 3.15pm after which time the students will leave the Beach. Please note that the students will not be supervised after 3.15pm.

Students can bring a packed lunch or buy lunch at the local shops. If your child is entitled to a free school lunch you will be contacted the week prior and you can request to take up this entitlement for the trip. Please use the My Child at School App to complete the required consents and update medical records, this can be found within the 'trips' section of the App.

Can I ask that students wear appropriately clothing and footwear for the day. Students should also bring sunscreen to reduce the risk of sunburn.
