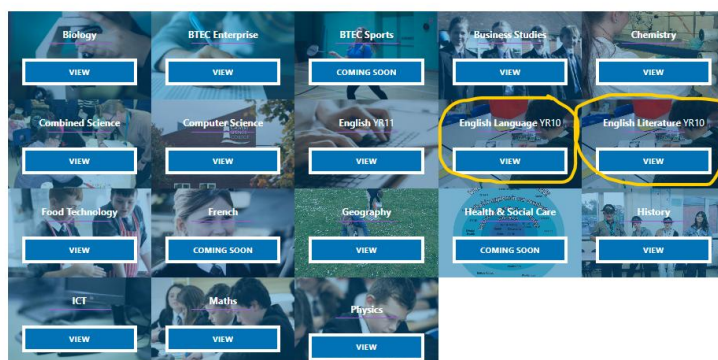
Dear Parents/carers,

### Year 10 Revision-English

As you may be aware, our year 10 students are coming up to an assessment period after half-term and to support them and yourselves in their success, I'd like to direct you to where revision resources can be located to boost students' independent study over the next few weeks.

On the JCSC website, we have a dedicated revision page: <https://www.jcsc.co.uk/revision/> and under the 'English Language Y10' and 'English Literature Yr10' buttons, there are lots of resources, created and devised by the English directorate, to support independent study and consolidation of skills taught in lessons. #### SUBJECT RESOURCES



It is important that students revise the following subjects:

- **Eduqas English Language Component 2 Non-Fiction Reading & Persuasive Writing (assessment date: 19<sup>th</sup> June 2025):** This will be English Language reading skills and the transactional writing skills- **Section A- Reading, Section B- Writing.**
- **AQA English Literature Paper 2 (Assessment date: 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2025 ):** **Modern Texts and Poetry-** This will have
  - ✓ **Section A- An Inspector Calls,**
  - ✓ **Section B- Power and Conflict poetry, and**
  - ✓ **Section C- Unseen poetry.**

Students will also have revision resources set by their English teacher on Google classroom to support them with each paper and they will need to take their English exercise books home, along with their Poetry Anthologies in order to revise content taught in lessons and notes made. Please ensure your child has done this but also returns these resources to school after the exam period.

After students have completed revision, it's also a good revision habit for them to then practise an exam style question. This is something that students are used to through the feedback loops that they complete bi-weekly, each Tuesday in English.
