Dear Parents and Carers,

**Year 9 English Assessment**

As we head towards the summer term, it is really important that we keep our expectations of our pupils in English high and ensure that they are on track to maintain progress as they head into year 10.

To this end, pupils will have an assessment on **Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> June** to track progress that pupils have made in English over the year. This assessment will be closely linked to content that they will have studied in lessons and associated homework that has been set. Assessments will take place in pupils normal lessons and feedback given once they have been marked.

Individual class teachers will speak to students about what the assessment will look like and how and what to revise in preparation for it.

Parents can support their children by ensuring that students are accessing revision material via Google Classroom and are using their exercise books as a revision tool.

Getting these revision habits embedded in Key Stage 3 will help students to be more confident with revision and organisational skills needed for the rigours of Key Stage 4 and Key Stage 5 (Years 10, 11, 12 & 13).
