Dear parents and carers,

Year 11 Prom – Alnwick Garden- Thursday 2nd July 2026

I hope this letter finds you well. I am delighted to share details about the Year 11 Prom, scheduled for Thursday 2nd July 2026. This special occasion is a big tradition in the JCSC calendar and is a fantastic way to celebrate the end of a busy exam period.

The Prom will be held at the beautiful Alnwick Garden, providing a memorable setting for this highlight of the academic year. The event will run from 7.00pm to 10.30pm. Students will arrive at JCSC from 6.00pm for a welcome drink in the main hall, with coaches leaving school for the event at 6.45pm. The coaches will leave the Alnwick Garden at 10.30pm and drop off at Widdrington, Hadston and Amble. Pupils will need to be collected from each of these drop off points at the end of the night.

Please note that attendance to the Prom is a privilege reserved for pupils who demonstrate excellent attendance and behaviour throughout the academic year. It was explained to the pupils in their Year 11 Welcome Assembly on 3rd September that any pupil who receives a suspension during this academic year will, unfortunately, be unable to attend. I must also make it clear that refunds will not be possible in the instance that a pupil's behaviour leads to removal from attending the Prom. This is in-line with our charging policy.

The price of a ticket for the Prom is £45 per student, this includes venue costs only. An initial non- refundable deposit of £20 must be paid to secure a place at the prom by 30th November. Final balance must be paid by 31st March.

Transport, welcome drinks and a range of entertainment, such as a candy floss stall, magician, caricature artist, photo booth, video booth and professional photographer were kindly sponsored by local businesses to reward and recognise the hard work of our Year 11 pupils. We anticipate a similar offer this year; without this sponsorship a ticket to our prom would have been significantly more expensive.
