



YOU ARE RECEIVING THIS LETTER AS YOUR CHILD'S ATTENDANCE IS OF CONCERN

Dear Parent/Carer.

As part of our commitment to improving the achievement of our students, we monitor attendance on a regular basis. The average attendance nationally in schools is 95% and research shows that students who achieve less than 95% attendance statistically will perform at one grade less than expected in examinations. The government classifies anyone with a school attendance of 90% or below as a persistent absentee (PA).

There are concerns regarding persistent absence (below 90%) of students in schools nationally and consequently there are important changes in the law and guidance regarding attendance (as per JCSC'S attendance letter to all parents, a copy of which can be found on the school website under school information). The legal changes are as follows: -

• There will be a new national threshold of 10 unauthorised sessions for any reason (equivalent to 5 school days) within a rolling 10 school week period for when a penalty notice must be considered. Registers will close at **9.15 am**.

To ensure our pupils gain full benefit from their education our school target is **97%**. We carried out a register check on **PUPIL NAME** and **PUPIL NAME** attendance is currently ***% which is in the **Red** Zone.



Red - Danger Zone - Below 90%

Amber – At Risk Zone – 91% - 96%

Green - Safety Zone - 97% - 100%

We will be monitoring their attendance, and we hope to see an immediate improvement. If your child is experiencing difficulties which affect their attendance, please contact Mr Robinson or a member of the Pastoral Team to discuss how we can best support you and your child.
