**To Kill A Mocking Bird, Newcastle Tyne Theatre, Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> April**

In Year 9 we have been studying the classic American text To Kill a Mockingbird and pupils have been engaging well with the multiple different themes of racism, segregation and prejudice that this classic text highlights.

To support our pupils further with their study of the novel, we have the unique opportunity to see this as a stage production at the Newcastle Tyne Theatre on the 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2026.

**The trip will cost a total of £28.50** which includes their theatre ticket and return coach travel (this is a discounted price). Tickets are available to purchase now via the **My Child At School app**.

Schedule for the day:

- Coach departs school at 12.15pm for Newcastle.
- Pupils on this trip will be able to access lunch earlier, with a limited menu available from our canteen.
- We will depart the theatre at around 4.30pm and expect to arrive back at school at 6pm.
- The coach will drop off pupils at Widdrington, Red Row, Hadston, Broomhill and school. Pupils can either be collected by parent/carers from these stops or make their usual own way home.
